Payment Policy: Payment is due to Trinity Lutheran Church and School as outlined on the Tuition and Registration Fees form for the applicable year. Accepted methods of payment include cash, personal check, credit card, or money order. If a personal check is returned due to a lack of funds, the parent/guardian must pay the returned check fee as assessed by Trinity Lutheran Church and School's bank. If a check is returned more than one time, only cash or money orders will be accepted as payment.

Termination Procedures: This contract may be terminated by the parent(s) or Trinity Lutheran Church and School. A 30-days written notice prior to the last date of preschool is required. Trinity Lutheran Church and School may immediately terminate this contract without any notice if payment is not made on time.

Other: If Trinity Lutheran Church and School chooses not to enforce any portion of the contract, it does not give up Trinity's right to enforce any other portion of the contract. The contract can be revised at any time by Trinity Lutheran Church and School, if necessary. This contract will be in effect for the **2021-2022** school year.
