Silence for reflection on God's Word and for self-examination.


- **P** Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

- C Amen.





possible with God." ³⁸And Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.



Luther's Morning Prayer




